

Let's Explore: Morocco!

Instructions: Read and look at the images to learn about Morocco and then answer the questions.

Morocco is a North African country with a population of more than 35 million people. The official name of the nation is the Kingdom of Morocco. Morocco is roughly the same size as California!

The Mediterranean Sea and the North Atlantic Ocean border Morocco, this is also where most of the population of the country resides. Morocco is the only country in Africa to have coastlines with



both the Atlantic and the Mediterranean.

The capital of Morocco is Rabat. The largest city in Morocco is Casablanca and is home to the largest port in the nation.

The languages spoken in Morocco are Arabic, French and Berber languages. However, Arabic is the official language of the country. The terrain of Morocco is mainly mountainous. The Atlas Mountains run through Morocco, Tunisia and Algeria. The highest point in Morocco is in these mountains and is called Jebel Toubkal, at 4,165m. The longest river in Morocco is the Dra River.
