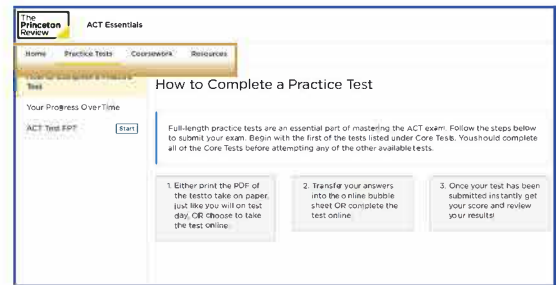

Take a Practice Test

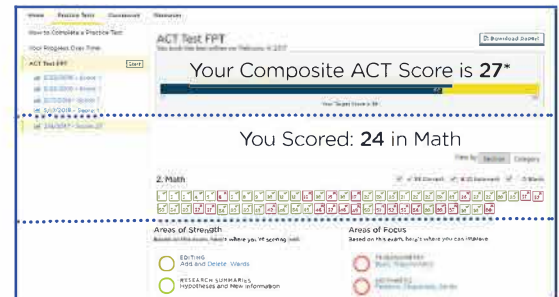

Review Your Scores

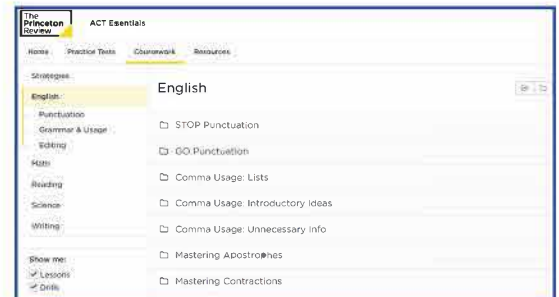

Complete Coursework

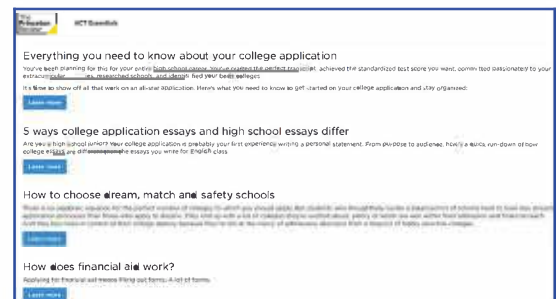
