

Tutor.com / NHED Partnership Fact Sheet for Districts

The New Hampshire Department of Education has partnered with Tutor.com to provide unlimited 24/7 online tutoring for every student in grades 4-12 statewide.

Through Tutor.com, students will gain no-cost, on-demand access to individualized tutoring, homework help, and test prep in a wide range of subjects, along with self-paced resources, including SAT®/ACT® Essentials from The Princeton Review®.

Districts have the option to sign up through the NHED partnership with Tutor.com to provide their students with single sign-on access to the platform. Participation provides easy access for students, and helpful usage data for districts.

Participation is optional and available at no cost for districts. A separate contract is not needed. District leaders may sign up here: <https://go.tutor.com/nhed-leaders>

Implementation process

- ✔ If your district chooses to participate, the Tutor.com technical implementation team will contact your IT team to integrate the service with your learning management system or platform and provide students with single sign-on access.
 - ▶ ***Platforms supported include: Google Workspace, Clever, ClassLink, Canvas, Blackboard, and other common learning management systems.***
 - ▶ ***The implementation queue will be an estimated 2-3 weeks turnaround from the time when the district official submits the participation request form.***
- ✔ A Tutor.com account will be created for your students, who will be able to access the service directly from your learning platform via single sign-on.
- ✔ Minimal student information (first name, last name, building, username/email) will be passed to Tutor.com from your learning platform to ensure secure authentication and to report their tutoring activity to your district. No additional data is required from the district.
- ✔ Once signed in, students will see terms and conditions, plus an honor code and privacy policies on their Tutor.com account page. Our privacy policy can be found here: <https://lhh.tutor.com/lhh/policies/terms-of-use.htm>

Your district's dedicated Tutor.com Customer Success Manager will also provide your district with marketing resources for students, parents, and teachers/staff to spread the word about free 24/7 tutoring, test prep, and other academic resources included in the Tutor.com platform.

- ▶ ***District contacts can opt to be set up for monthly reports and client portal access to view secure usage reports for their district/school.***
 - ▶ ***Tutor.com will be providing training events throughout the fall and spring for teachers and other district leaders to learn more about how the service can benefit your students.***
 - ▶ ***Tutor.com will also be hosting open-house sessions for students and parents in your district so they can learn about how to make the most of Tutor.com access.***
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Students attending districts who choose not to enroll with Tutor.com, individual parents/guardians and students, and students over the age of 13 will be able to sign up through a General Access program launching in mid-September. Tutor.com is available to students not associated with a public school district, including those students in private schools, home education students, and Education Freedom Account programs.

- ▶ ***The New Hampshire General Access Tutor.com program will be made available through a self-registration form requesting student information. Parental consent is required if the student is under the age of 13, and enrollment is contingent upon acceptance of general terms and conditions.
