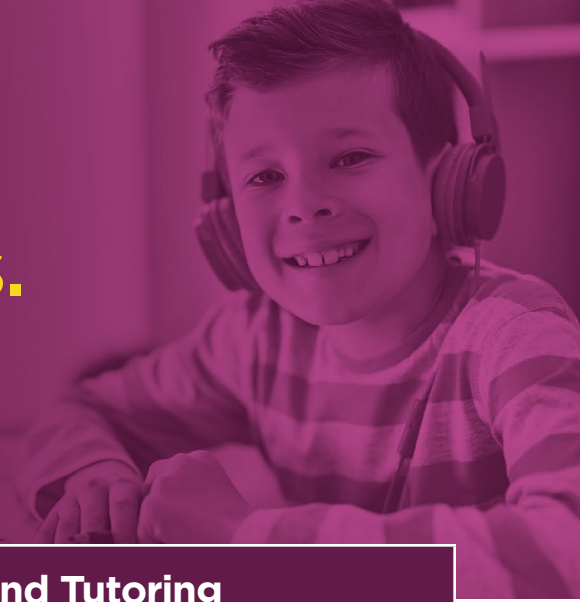


# High-Dosage Tutoring vs. On-Demand Tutoring

High-Dosage Tutoring	On-Demand Tutoring
 Curricular content (optional) and instruction from The Princeton Review® and Tutor.com	 Instruction from Tutor.com expert tutors
Intensive, 3+ times/week	As-needed
Fixed session length of 30–60 minutes	Variable session durations, typically about 25–30 minutes each
Pre-scheduled, during the school day	24/7, on-demand
Targeted support to produce large learning gains for students who have fallen behind	Individualized support to help students close small knowledge gaps
Small-group (up to 4 students)	1-to-1
Relational, with a consistent tutor	Varied tutors
Subject-focused in Algebra (additional topics to be added)	Available in 250+ subjects
Assessment-driven, with performance tracked in the Teacher Dashboard	Student-led support, with transcripts available in the Teacher Dashboard
Personalized Learning Plans, along with Lesson Reports after each session	General tutor feedback and as-needed early intervention alerts
Ideal for students who may not seek help on their own	Ideal for students who may need help episodically
Significant, measurable academic improvement in key subject area	Incremental, quantifiable improvement in confidence, assignment completion, and grades
