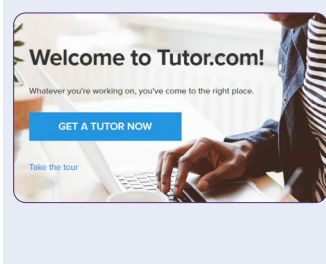

Access Live Tutoring

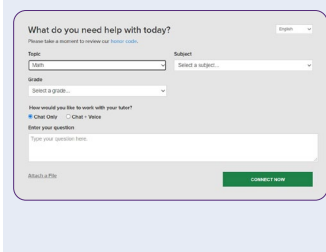
Step 1: Get started

Fill in the quick pre-session questionnaire. Using this information, we will match you with the first available tutor best qualified to assist you.



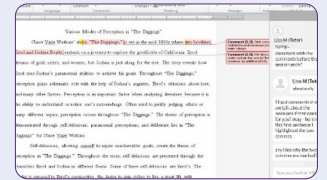
Step 3: Communicate

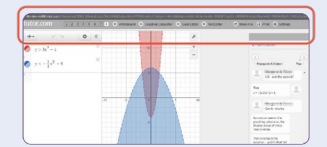
Step 4: Share a file

You can upload files related to your assignment to the online classroom—including documents, spreadsheets, presentation slides, screenshots, image files, and more.



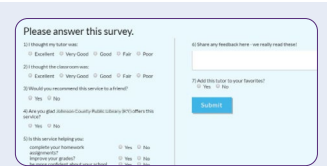
Step 5: Use special tools

Step 6: Rate and review your session

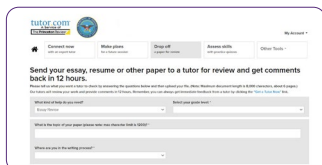
After each session, be sure to let us know how we did! Then you'll have the option to play a recording of your session and email or print the chat log and whiteboards.

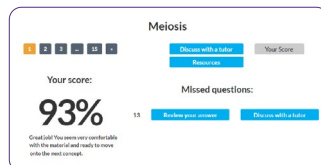
Submit your paper
