Step 1: Get started


Log in to **Schoology**®, and navigate to any of your **COURSES**.



Step 2: Navigate to Tutor.com

Scroll down and click the **Tutor.com** button on the left.

*If you'd like to learn more about everything you can do with Tutor.com, click the **TAKE A TOUR** button.*




Step 3: Find the right tutor

Click **Connect with a Tutor Now** at the top-left corner or the **CONNECT NOW** button. Then, select your language, topic, subject, and grade level.

When you're in our online classroom, you can use text- and/or voice-chat to communicate with your tutor. Click **Chat Only** or **Chat with Voice**, whichever option is most comfortable for you.

You can also share questions and files you'd like to discuss. Upload any assignment you're working on. You and your tutor will be able to look at your work together in the classroom.




Step 4: Start your session

Click on the **SUBMIT** button to quickly connect with an incredible tutor. The tutoring classroom will pop up in a new window.

*If you need help remembering something your tutor said, classroom sessions are recorded so that you can review them later in **My Account** under **Completed Sessions**.*

Step 5: Rate and review your session

Step 6: End your session


Once you finish rating and reviewing your session, simply close the Tutor.com window.



Use Special Tools




Use My Account

Reconnect with your favorite tutors or see when they are next available by clicking on **Favorite Tutors**.


Review previous sessions and retrieve feedback on your drop-off reviews under **Completed Sessions**.



Writing Help


