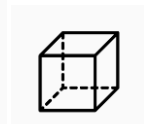
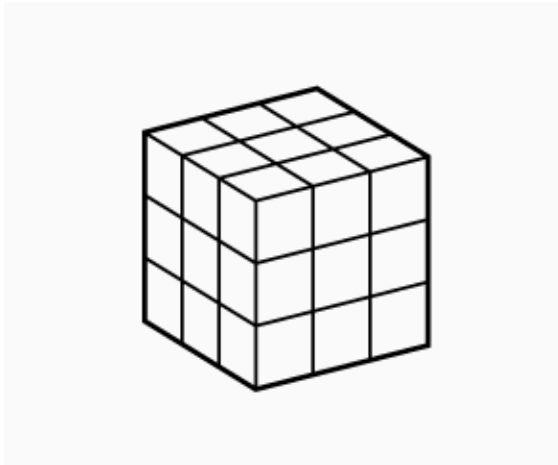


Measuring Volume
